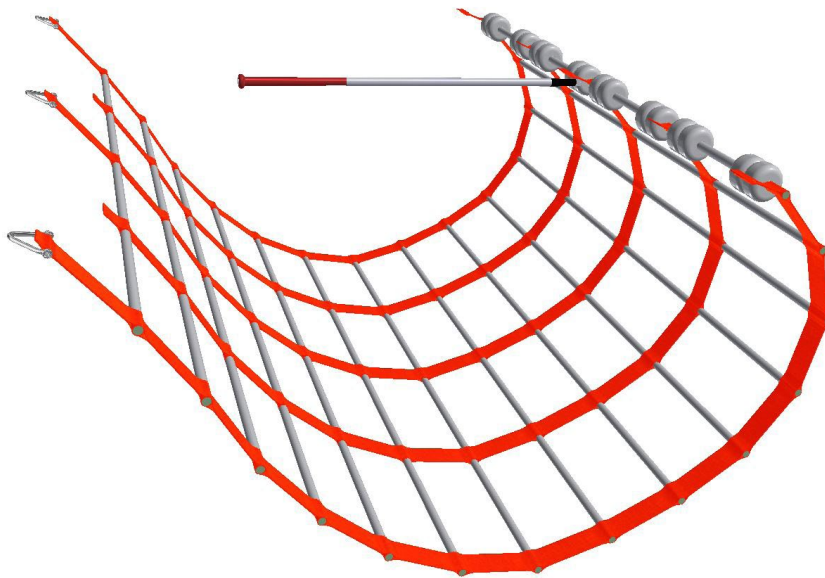

The Dacon Rescue Frame consists of a number of parallel fibre glass bars connected by slotted webbing. The outer bar is equipped with flotation, a manoeuvring stick and hand-loops for easy grip. When deployed, the rescue frame hangs down the freeboard forming a cradle in the water. The casualty is positioned in the cradle and gently rolled onboard by lifting the grip bar or the retrieval lines. With the optional hydraulic drum and davit, recovery can be performed single-handed. Available for any freeboard height. The system stows in a minimum of space.
